TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Sponsorship

The International Alps Art Academy is supported by the association of the Beverin Nature Park. The park is involved in the sustainable development of the Safien Valley in the areas of nature, culture, commerce, tourism and agriculture and is responsible for the Alps Art Academy and Art Safiental.

Academy

The Alps Art Academy is open to all artists who are interested in working with landscapes and the environment, as well as theoreticians, facilitators and curators engaged in research on the subject of land and environmental art. The minimum age for participation is 18 years. The maximum number of participants is 30.

Fee

The program costs are subsidised by the Alps Art Academy and other partners. The Alps Art Academy strives to keep the participation fee as low as possible. In 2018 the fee is CHF 1200.-, USD 1200.-, EUR 1000.- (10 days academy, accommodation in a double room, meals, excursions during the academy), excluding travel expenses. For participants who need financial support are invited to apply for a scholarship.

The participation fee covers the cost of taking part in all course modules at the Academy under the direction of a qualified artist, mediator, curator or art critic as well as transport during field trips, accommodation, meals and participation in various other events at the Alps Art Academy. The cost of travel to and from the Academy, materials and private expenses are not included in the fee.

Stipendium

The academy encourages a broad mix of participants (age, gender, origin), which is why low-income applicants have the opportunity to apply for a reduction of the academy fee and / or travel expenses up to a maximum of 100%. For this please provide a justification on the application form (DE or EN, max 600 characters) in addition to the regular application documents. A committee consisting of the project's directorate will decide on the granting of scholarships. Applicants have no legal entitlement.

Notification / Payment

All participants will receive confirmation via e-mail of the receipt of their application. If you did not receive an e-mail by April 01, 2018, please contact us at organisation@alpsartacademy.ch. All selected participants will be sent notification by email latest by April 15, 2018.

Selected candidates must agree to transfer the participation fee to the Alps Art Academy within 30 days (by 15.5.18). If your deposit has not reached us by May 15, 2018 the commitment will be forfeited and the place will be passed on to a candidate on the waiting list. From 15.5 2018, any places still open will be re-assigned.

After receipt of payments the names of the participants will be published on the website (from 31 May 2018).

Cancellation

In case of cancellation after May 15, 2018, a fee of CHF 200 will be retained for expenses incurred. A refund of the full participation fee is only possible in proven cases of „force majeure“ (illness, accident, death in the family). An immediate cancellation with written proof of the reason is required, otherwise the full course fee is payable. Other reasons (dissatisfaction, program changes) do not entitle the participant to a refund. After the start of the Alps Art Academy, cancellation is no longer possible.

Insurance

The Alps Art Academy is not liable for any accident, theft or damage of any kind occurring during the Academy (28.06.-08.07.2018). Personal liability, health and accident insurance is the responsibility of the participants.

Safety

Participants visit the artistic interventions and excursion sites at their own risk.

Validity

These terms and conditions are valid from 19 January 2018. Ancillary verbal agreements require the written approval of the Alps Art Academy project management team and these terms and conditions will remain generally applicable.
